# HCC SIM Grant Management Update

- **Quarterly Progress Report** submitted to CMMI on Nov. 30; once approved, will be available on HCC website
- **Year 3 Operational Plan** due on Dec. 1
  - Will include operational work plans, driver diagram, monitoring and evaluation plans, sustainability plan, budget, milestones and metrics
  - HCC has **worked closely with DCHI** to develop plans for Year 3
  - Once approved, will be available on HCC website
- Round 2 of **Behavioral Health EMR Assistance Program** RFP posted on Nov. 2; go to <http://bids.delaware.gov> to view; deadline is Dec. 9
- Planning a **Learning Collaborative** for providers participating in Practice Transformation on Jan. 24 in Dover; details/agenda being finalized, will be available on HCC website

# Highlights of Year 3 Operational Plan

- **Budget request** of \$5.6M
  - Focus of program funds on Clinical/Delivery transformation, Health IT and Healthy Neighborhoods
    - Continuing Practice Transformation support, BH EMR assistance, Common Scorecard, curriculum, and strategic consulting support
    - Launching Behavioral Health Integration plan, funding Healthy Neighborhoods and supporting provider outreach
- Will apply for **Carryover funds** to support unfinished Year 2 activities and supplement ongoing initiatives
- **Sustainability plan** focuses on development of DCHI as the entity to carry the work forward

# DCHI update

- The DCHI Board will review its draft **strategic plan** at its Dec. board meeting
- Progress is being made on a variety of initiatives:
  - Discussions about the future path for the **Common Scorecard**
  - Approval of the **Patient and Consumer consensus paper**, “Achieving Meaningful Patient and Consumer Engagement”
  - Reorganizing the **Healthy Neighborhoods Committee** to add three Work Groups to provide greater support to the Local Councils
    - Data
    - Sustainability
    - CHNA/Clinical Advisory
  - Wilmington/Claymont Local Council being developed, on schedule to launch in Jan. 2017
