HCC SIM Grant Management Update

- Currently in Year 2 of CMMI State Innovation Model Cooperative Agreement
- Must submit an Operational Plan for Year 3 in order to be approved for continued funding
 - Operational Plan due December 1
 - Will include operational work plans, driver diagram, monitoring and evaluation plans, sustainability plans, budget, milestones and metrics
 - HCC is working closely with DCHI to develop plans for Year 3
- Full budget update will be provided in November, as Grant Q3 ends Oct. 31

DCHI update

- The DCHI Board is currently engaged in a strategic planning process to develop DCHI's direction for the next 3 – 5 years
- Progress is being made on a variety of initiatives:
 - Final Common Scorecard functionality being developed/tested for October launch
 - Plan for launch of Behavioral Health Integration (BHI) testing program being developed in collaboration with HCC
 - Under the Payment Committee, a Transparency Working Group has kicked-off which will evolve priority use cases identified by Spring 2016 HCCD white paper
 - Workforce curriculum currently being developed by vendor, with first module launching in November
 - Healthy Neighborhoods has hired a Program Director and a Community Coordinator for Wilmington
 - Board and staff conducting outreach to providers via professional society meetings, town halls, and payer forums to share information on resources, tools, and support available through DCHI programs
