- Delaware Healthcare Association Forum on 10/30




Summary of October DCHI Board meeting

Transforming Clinical Practices FOAs (1/2)

Opportunity

- CMMI recently announced a new funding opportunity focused on practice transformation, the **Transforming Clinical Practices Initiative** (TCPI)
- Two distinct Funding Opportunity Announcements:
 - **Practice Transformation Networks (PTNs)** are peer-based learning networks that will recruit practices, facilitate improved practice management, and use quality measures to track progress
 - Providers are likely applicants
 - Support up to \$670M over ~35 awards
 - **Support and Alignment Networks (SANs)** will promote workforce development by aligning memberships and communications to support PTNs and practices
 - Professional associations among likely applicants
 - Support up to \$30M over ~30 awards
