# Summary of September Board meeting


- **Approved version 2 of the Common Scorecard**, including discussion of:

  - Level of current **alignment with payers on measures** for a proposed **version 2 of the Common Scorecard**

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- **Approved the Healthy Neighborhoods Operating Model paper**, which provides an overview of approach, structure, governance and geographic boundaries

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# Reminder: Support available for primary care providers

## Practice Transformation

- All primary care practices eligible to apply for SIM-grant-funded practice transformation support
- Vendor(s) will provide a standard level of support, with a curriculum tailored to each individual practice's needs

**Vendors to be selected in Q4 2015 with support beginning in Q1 2016**

## Care Coordination

- Payers are encouraged to qualify PCPs for care coordination funding if they:
  - Achieve reasonable performance standards for quality of care
  - Demonstrate commitment and progress toward building the capabilities necessary for effective population health management
- Whenever possible, payers should structure care coordination payments as a risk-adjusted PMPM sufficient to cover costs, with shared expectations regarding the scope and intensity

## Outcomes-based payments

- Payers should offer both Total Cost of Care (TCC) as well as Pay for Value (P4V) models for providers
- Both TCC and P4V models should require providers to meet goals for quality and efficiency, tied to the Common Scorecard

# Near-term priorities

- Finalize October beta release of **Common Scorecard**
- Develop **Health IT roadmap**
- Begin developing approach to **Behavioral Health Integration**
- Define **Healthy Neighborhoods phased rollout plan** in further detail (e.g., support to be provided to Neighborhoods)
- Continue design of **value-based payment models**, including timing and pace of rollout
