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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2015, 47 Delaware nursing homes operated a total of 4,894 licensed beds. The majority of Delaware nursing homes – 44 out of 47 – were privately owned and operated in 2015. Privately-owned licensed beds accounted for 93.6 percent of all licensed nursing home beds in Delaware. Delaware’s three publicly-operated nursing home facilities (Emily P. Bissell Hospital, Governor Bacon Health Center, and the Delaware Hospital for the Chronically Ill) accounted for the remaining 6.4 percent of statewide nursing home beds.

Since 2005, overall occupancy rates for private facilities in all three counties have hovered near 90 percent. Over the same time period, Delaware’s public nursing homes have operated at occupancy rates ranging from a low of 51.5% (2013) to a high of 67.7% (2015). The annual number of admissions to private Delaware nursing homes has substantially increased since 2005; however, increases in the number of admitted patients have been most dramatic in Kent and Sussex Counties.

From 2005-2015, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in Kent and Sussex Counties increased 85.3 percent and 63.2 percent, respectively. Over the same time period, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in New Castle County increased 15.8 percent. From 2014 to 2015, admissions to Delaware nursing homes fell marginally across all three counties; in New Castle, Kent, and Sussex Counties, admissions declined 4.0 percent, 6.6 percent, and 7.8 percent, respectively. The DHCC will continue to monitor annual nursing home admissions data to determine if this represents a newly-emerging trend or an aberration in trend.

In 2015, a total of 11,892 patients were admitted to Delaware nursing homes. Of this total, white patients accounted for 80.5 percent of all admissions. Black patients and patients of other races accounted for 17.9 percent and 1.7 percent of 2015 nursing home admissions, respectively. Compared to their white counterparts, black patients and patients of other races admitted to Delaware nursing homes are younger on average. Similar demographic trends are observed for discharges from Delaware nursing homes.

The growing size and the changing demographics of Delaware’s population are central to the understanding of the distribution of nursing homes, the number of licensed nursing home beds, and their utilization. Between 2010 and 2040, Delaware’s total population is expected to increase 19.4 percent. Projected population growth is much more dramatic among older Delawareans. From 2010 to 2040, the statewide population of Delawareans age 65 and older is expected to increase 98.7 percent (nearly doubling from 130,134 to 258,540).

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I. INTRODUCTION

This, the 29th edition of the Delaware Nursing Home Utilization Statistical Report, summarizes 2015 data submitted by Delaware nursing homes¹. On a monthly basis, from January through December 2015, Delaware nursing homes submitted utilization data to the Delaware Health Care Commission (DHCC). To accomplish this, the DHCC contacted nursing home facilities on the first day of each month via e-mail to request facility utilization data for the previous month; if a facility's monthly data submission was delayed, then follow-up contact was made via fax and telephone. Upon initial data submission, the DHCC converted the data to an electronic format and reviewed each facility's report for internal inconsistencies and unexpected changes in reported statistics. Any discrepancies were immediately communicated back to the facility with a request for updated data. After receipt of any updated data, a facility's report was considered complete for the month. At the end of the reporting year, the DHCC re-coded and tabulated data to yield annual utilization data by facility and county.

This report presents 2015 Delaware nursing home data in two main sections. The **Facility Characteristics** section highlights historical trend data from 2005 through 2015. The majority of data presented in this section are aggregated to the state- and county-level, and primarily focus on indicators of utilization and patient demographics. The **Tables** section presents detailed facility-level measures, including total patient days, occupancy rates, percentage of patients by source of payment, and annual admission and discharge totals. Note that percentages in any given data category may not sum to 100 percent due to numerical rounding. Refer to Appendix A for changes in facilities' names and/or number of licensed beds that occurred in 2015.


¹ Excluded from this report are facilities that serve individuals under the age of 18, as well as Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with Intellectual Developmental Disabilities (ICF/IID). ICF/IID facilities provide active and comprehensive and individualized treatment and rehabilitation services to promote functional status and independence.

STATEWIDE POPULATION PROJECTIONS

The growing size and the changing demographics of Delaware's population are central to the understanding of the distribution of nursing homes, the number of licensed nursing home beds, and their utilization. The following two charts, derived from Delaware Population Consortium data, provide the context within which to evaluate the availability of facilities for the elderly. Chart 1 shows the projected increase of Delaware's total population from 2010 to 2040. Chart 2 shows the projected population increase over the same time period specifically among Delawareans age 65 and older.


Between 2010 and 2040, Delaware's total population is expected to increase 19.4 percent (from 899,716 in 2010 to 1,074,556 in 2040). Overall population growth is distributed unevenly across Delaware's counties; from 2010-2040, Kent and Sussex Counties are expected to experience a 28.1 percent and 30.8 percent increase in total population, respectively. Total population growth for New Castle County is estimated at 12.7 percent over the same time period. Projected population growth is much more dramatic among older Delawareans. From 2010 to 2040, the statewide population of Delawareans age 65 and older is expected to increase 98.7 percent (nearly doubling from 130,134 to 258,540). Among this subpopulation, cohorts of the oldest Delawareans are expected to increase most rapidly in size. Between 2010 and 2040, statewide percentages of residents age 75-79, 80-84, and 85+ are projected to increase 120.6 percent, 143.8 percent, and 203.2 percent, respectively.

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II. FACILITY CHARACTERISTICS

NUMBER OF NURSING HOME BEDS


In 2015, 47 Delaware nursing homes operated a total of 4,894 licensed beds. The majority of Delaware nursing homes – 44 out of 47 – were privately owned and operated in 2015. Privately-owned licensed beds accounted for 93.6 percent of all licensed nursing home beds in Delaware. Delaware’s three publicly-operated nursing home facilities (Emily P. Bissell Hospital, Governor Bacon Health Center, and the Delaware Hospital for the Chronically Ill) accounted for the remaining 6.4 percent of statewide nursing home beds. (Note that the Emily P. Bissell Hospital ceased admitting new patients in April 2015 and permanently closed in September 2015).

The map on the following page shows the geographic location of Delaware nursing homes. Each circular symbol represents one nursing home. The size of the circular symbol corresponds to the number of licensed beds at that facility. In 2015, New Castle County was home to 27 private nursing homes and two public nursing homes. Kent County housed six private nursing homes and one public nursing home. The remaining 11 private nursing homes were located in Sussex County.

UTILIZATION

A commonly-used measure of nursing home utilization is the number of billable patient days generated by a facility over a given time period. A billable patient day represents a unit of time (i.e., one day) during which the facility's services are used by one patient. For example, if a nursing home has 100 patients on a particular day, the facility has generated 100 billable patient days for that particular 24-hour period. If a facility's number of billable patient days increases from one time period to the next, it is an indication that the facility is caring for more patients, caring for patients for longer periods of time, or a combination of these two factors. Mathematically, billable patient days per facility per year are calculated by summing each facility's monthly billable patient days over a 12-month period.

Long-term trends reveal sizeable shifts in the number of patient days by county and facility type. From 2005-2015, New Castle County and Sussex County private nursing homes experienced a 8.2 percent and 12.3 percent increase in billable patient days, respectively. During the same time period, private nursing homes in Kent County experienced a substantially larger 28.7 percent increase in billable patient days. From 2005 to 2015, billable patient days among Delaware's public nursing homes declined 43.2 percent.

OCCUPANCY

Occupancy rates are helpful for putting facilities' utilization data within the context of available resources. A facility's occupancy rate reflects the percentage of available beds occupied by patients throughout the reporting year. Occupancy rates were weighted based on the number of days a facility was open during the reporting year. Mathematically, for facilities that were open 365 days of the reporting year,

$$\text{Weighted Occupancy Rate} = \left[\frac{\text{Number of Billable Patient Days}}{\text{Number of Licensed Bed Days}} \right] * 100\%$$

where (Number of Licensed Bed Days) equaled the number of licensed beds in a facility (calculated as the average number of beds over the entire 12-month period) multiplied by 365. If a facility was open fewer than 365 days of the reporting year, the same weighted occupancy formula was used with the exception that (Number of Licensed Bed Days) equaled the number of licensed beds multiplied by the actual number of days the facility was open.

Since 2005, overall occupancy rates for private facilities in all three counties have hovered near 90 percent. From 2005 to 2015, the overall occupancy rate for private facilities fluctuated only slightly (ranging from a 0.4 percent decline in Sussex County to a 2.6 percent increase in New Castle County). Over the same time period, Delaware's public nursing homes have operated at occupancy rates ranging from a low of 51.5% (2013) to a high of 67.7% (2015). From 2005 to 2015, occupancy rates in Delaware's three public facilities increased 8.5 percent; however, this reflects a reduction in licensed public nursing home beds rather than an increase in admissions to public nursing homes (see Table 4 for additional details).

ADMISSIONS

The annual number of admissions to private Delaware nursing homes has substantially increased since 2005; however, increases in the number of admitted patients have been most dramatic in Kent and Sussex Counties. From 2005-2015, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in Kent and Sussex Counties increased 85.3 percent and 63.2 percent, respectively. Over the same time period, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in New Castle County increased 15.8 percent. From 2014 to 2015, admissions to Delaware nursing homes fell marginally across all three counties; in New Castle, Kent, and Sussex Counties, admissions declined 4.0 percent, 6.6 percent, and 7.8 percent, respectively. The DHCC will continue to monitor annual nursing home admissions data to determine if this represents a newly-emerging trend or an aberration in trend.

While private nursing home admissions have substantially increased across all three counties since 2005, annual admissions to public nursing homes in Delaware have been more erratic. Since 2005, public nursing homes in Delaware have experienced substantial fluctuations in the number of patients admitted each year. Considering the most recent 11 years' worth of data, the peak number of public nursing home admissions occurred in 2006 when 156 patients were admitted to Delaware's three public nursing homes. In 2015, this number fell to 64 patients. Compared to 2005, 55.9 percent fewer patients were admitted to Delaware public nursing homes in 2015.


As shown in Table 5, white patients accounted for 80.5 percent of all Delaware nursing home admissions in 2015. Black patients and patients of other races accounted for 17.9 percent and 1.7 percent of 2015 nursing home admissions, respectively. When considering admissions by age, individuals 75-84 years and 85 years and over accounted for 32.1 percent and 32.2 percent, respectively, of all 2015 Delaware nursing home admissions. Just over one-fifth (21.0 percent) of 2015 nursing home admissions were individuals ages 65-74. The youngest category of nursing home patients – those under age 65 – accounted for the remaining 14.6 percent of 2015 admissions.

Although black patients and patients of other races comprised just under one-fifth (19.6 percent) of all 2015 nursing home admissions combined, they represent an overall younger population compared to their white counterparts. As shown in Figure 2, in 2015, just 12 percent of all white nursing home admissions were individuals under the age of 65. Relative to this, individuals under the age of 65 accounted for 26.3 percent of black admissions. Among black patients admitted to Delaware nursing homes in 2015, 52 percent were individuals age 74 and under; in comparison, 32 percent of all white admissions represented individuals under the age of 74. In summary, while white patients accounted for substantially more nursing home admissions overall, black patients and patients of other races tended to be younger when they admitted to Delaware nursing homes.

DISCHARGES

In 2015, Delaware nursing homes discharged a total of 11,526 patients. Since 2005, the annual number of discharges from private Delaware nursing homes has substantially increased across all three counties. From 2005-2015, Kent and Sussex Counties experienced the greatest increase in the number of annual private nursing home discharges (100.0 percent and 60.4 percent, respectively). Private nursing home discharges increased 12.6 percent in New Castle County over the same time period. Compared to 2005, Delaware’s public nursing homes experienced a 21.1 percent decline in the number of annual discharges; however, this decline in the number of discharges mirrors a similar decline in the number of annual admissions among Delaware’s public nursing homes.

As in previous years, in 2015, discharge destination varied greatly by facility type (Table 7). Patients discharged from private facilities were far more likely to return home compared to patients discharged from public facilities (59.9 percent vs. 4.1 percent, respectively). Approximately one-third of patients discharged from public nursing home facilities represented discharges due to death; among discharges from private nursing homes, just fewer over 10 percent represented discharges due to death.

As shown in Table 8, 2015 discharge statistics mirror admission statistics in terms of patient race and age. White patients accounted for 80.4 percent of all Delaware nursing home discharges in 2015. Black patients and patients of other races accounted for 17.9 percent and 1.7 percent of 2015 nursing home discharges, respectively. When considering discharges by age category, individuals 75-84 years and


85 years and over accounted for 31.4 percent and 33.5 percent, respectively, of all Delaware nursing home discharges. Just over one-fifth (20.5 percent) of 2015 nursing home discharges were individuals ages 65-74. The youngest category of nursing home patients – those under age 65 – accounted for the remaining 14.7 percent of 2015 discharges.

The age breakdown among white, black, and other race patients discharged from Delaware nursing homes in 2015 is similar to that among nursing home admissions. Black patients and patients of other races discharged from Delaware nursing homes represent and overall younger population. Approximately 26 percent of black patients and 17 percent of patients of other races discharged from nursing homes were under the age of 65, whereas only 12 percent of white patients discharged from Delaware nursing homes fell into this youngest age category. In 2015, nearly 53 percent of black patients discharged from Delaware nursing homes were under the age of 75; in comparison, 31.0 percent of white patients discharged from Delaware nursing homes were under the age of 75. In summary, while white patients accounted for substantially more nursing home discharges overall, black patients and patients of other races discharged from Delaware nursing homes represent a younger population in general.

SOURCE OF PAYMENT

Patient payment for nursing home care varies by type of facility. In 2015, the overwhelming majority (88.0 percent) of patients in public Delaware nursing homes used Medicaid as a source of payment; among patients at private Delaware nursing homes, just under 60 percent utilized Medicaid funds. Although the percentage of private nursing home patients using Medicare has increased slowly since 2005, Medicare is still not a major payer of nursing home care in Delaware. In 2015, 0.4 percent and 18.2 percent of patients in public and private nursing homes, respectively, used Medicare as their source of payment. Approximately 18 percent of private nursing home patients self-paid for their care, compared to 8.5 percent of public nursing home patients. Between three and four percent of patients in both public and private nursing homes used a different source of payment for their care.
