Highlights from the FY 17 GRB include:

- \$1.9 million to provide full-year funding to support operations for the eligibility system;
- \$539.2 to support General Assistance caseload growth and maintain the current monthly benefit at \$81/month; and,
- (\$55.2) reduction in the ASF Tobacco SSI Supplement program.
