Driving Directions:

From the North, I-95 and Route 1:

Take I-95 South to Exit 4B (Route 1 South). Take Route 1 South to Exit 104 (North Dover). At the stop light at Route 13, go straight across Route 13 onto Scarborough Road. Del Tech campus will be on your right. This road will curve left and turn into McKee Road. Follow it about 1 mile. There are several lights. When you reach the Route 8 intersection/light, cross over and continue straight. When you reach Hazletville Road, turn left. Continue on Hazletville Road crossing over the train track and make the next left turn on to Slaughter Street. On your left you will see a modern five story building – Duncan Center. Enter the parking lot to the left. You will be at the rear of the building. The main entrance is located on the opposite side of the building where limited on street parking is also available.

From the Southwest/Seaford/Laurel Areas, Route 13:

Take Route 13 North to Dover. You will pass Wawa on your left and Royal Farms on your right. Immediately past Royal Farms, Route 13 will merge with Route 113. Turn left onto E. Lookerman Street at the first intersection following the merge (TGI Friday's Restaurant will be on your left). Go over the bridge, past the post office and continue thru downtown (approximately ¾ mile). After crossing Queen Street, on your left you will see a modern five story building – Duncan Center (if you cross the railroad track you have gone too far). There is parking on the street (front and side) and a back parking lot.

From the Southeast/Beach Areas, Route 113:

Take Route 1 to Exit 95 (Route 113 North). Continue north past the Blue Hen Corporate Center on your right. On the left is the Department of Transportation and DMV. Continue North on Route 113 approximately ¾ mile. Immediately past Royal Farms to your left, Route 113 will merge with Route 13. At the merge you will want to move into the left lane so you can turn left onto E. Lookerman Street at the light. TGI Friday's Restaurant is on the left. Go over the bridge, past the post office and continue thru downtown (approximately ¾ mile). After crossing Queen Street, on your left you will see a modern five story building – Duncan Center (if you cross the railroad track you have gone too far). There is parking on the street (front and side) and a back parking lot.
