State Funding to Provide Delaware Residents With Opportunities

DIMER

- DE Institute for Medical Education and Research
- Established in 1969 as alternative to state-supported medical school
- DIMER funds pay to reserve "slots" for DE residents
- Tuition assistance also funded
- State match for federal loan repayment

DIDER

- DE Institute for Dental Education and Research
- Established in 1981 as alternative to state-supported dental school
- DIDER funds pay to reserve "slots" for DE residents
- Tuition assistance is <u>not</u> funded
- State match for federal loan repayment

Longstanding Relationships with Philadelphia Schools

Both medical schools often accept more Delaware applicants than the contracted number of slots.



Education and Training Locations Matter

- 29% of physicians who complete GME in DE stay in DE to practice medicine
- There were 357 residents in 2016
- On average, states with a public medical school retain almost 45% of graduates
