## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2012, 47 Delaware nursing homes operated a total of 5,081 licensed beds across the state. Forty-four of these facilities were private nursing homes, accounting for 89 percent of all licensed nursing home beds in Delaware. Delaware's three publicly-operated nursing home facilities (Emily P. Bissell Hospital, Governor Bacon Health Center, and the Delaware Hospital for the Chronically Ill) accounted for the remaining 11 percent of statewide nursing home beds.

Since 2002, overall occupancy rates for private nursing homes in all three Delaware counties have hovered near 90 percent. Over the past 10 years, the most noticeable decline in occupancy rates has been among public nursing home facilities. From 2002 to 2012, the overall occupancy rate for public facilities fell nearly 10 percent (from 64.2 percent to 54.3 percent). Similarly, the annual number of admissions to private Delaware nursing homes has steadily increased since 2002; however, increases in the number of admitted patients have been most dramatic in Kent and Sussex Counties. From 2002-2012, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in Kent and Sussex Counties increased 97.0 percent and 99.4 percent, respectively. Over the same time period, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in New Castle County increased 43.2 percent. From 2002-2012, public nursing home admissions fell 69.9 percent across Delaware.

White patients accounted for nearly 81 percent of all Delaware nursing home admissions in 2012. Black patients and patients of other races accounted for 17.4 percent and 1.7 percent of 2012 nursing home admissions, respectively. While whites account for substantially more nursing home admissions overall, black patients and patients of other races tend to be younger when they are admitted to Delaware nursing homes. Similar geographic and demographic trends are observed for discharges from Delaware nursing homes.

The overwhelming majority (81.2 percent) of patients in public Delaware nursing homes used Medicaid as a source of payment; among patients at private Delaware nursing homes, just over 55 percent paid by way of Medicaid. Although the percentage of private nursing home patients using Medicare has increased slowly since 2002, Medicare is still not a major payer of nursing home care in Delaware. In 2012, 18.8 percent and 0.3 percent of patients in private and public nursing homes, respectively, used Medicare as their source of payment.

The growing size and the changing demographics of Delaware's population are central to the understanding of the distribution of nursing homes, the number of licensed nursing home beds, and their utilization. Between 2010 and 2040, Delaware's total population is expected to increase 22 percent. Projected population growth is much more dramatic among older Delawareans. From 2010 to 2040, the statewide population of Delawareans age 65 and older is expected to increase 99 percent (nearly doubling from 130,301 to 258,905).

## I. INTRODUCTION

This is the 26<sup>th</sup> edition of the Delaware Nursing Home Utilization Statistical Report. This report presents characteristics of Delaware's nursing homes and their patients. The data in this report do not include intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded (ICFMR). ICFMR facilities provide active treatment services to people with mental retardation and other related conditions that cause adaptive behavior similar to that of the mentally retarded person and which manifest before the person reaches the age of 22. Also, this report does not include data from facilities that serve individuals under the age of 18.

This report summarizes 2012 data submitted by Delaware nursing homes. On a monthly basis, from January through December 2012, Delaware nursing homes submitted utilization data to the University of Delaware's Center for Applied Demography & Survey Research (CADSR). To accomplish this, the CADSR contacted facilities on the first day of each month using a combination of standard mail and e-mail; follow-up contact was made via fax and phone if a facility's monthly data submission was delayed. Using these methods, the CADSR achieved full compliance from all facilities for all 12 months. Upon initial data submission, the CADSR converted the data to an electronic format (if not already done so by the facility). Additionally, the CADSR checked each facility's report for internal inconsistencies and unexpected changes in reported statistics. Any discrepancies were immediately communicated back to the facility with a request for updated data. After receipt of updated data, that facility's report was considered complete for the month. At the end of the reporting year, the CADSR recoded and tabulated data as needed.


This report presents Delaware nursing home data in two sections. The **Facility Characteristics** section highlights trend data from 2002 through 2012. The majority of data presented in this section represents data aggregated at the state- and county-levels. This section focuses primarily on utilization data and patient demographics. The **Tables** section presents facility-level characteristics such as total patient days, occupancy rate, and patients by source of payment, along with number of admissions and discharges. Please note that throughout this report, percentages in any given data category may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding. Refer to Appendix A for changes in facilities' names and/or number of licensed beds that occurred in 2012.

## **STATEWIDE POPULATION PROJECTIONS**

The growing size and the changing demographics of Delaware's population are central to the understanding of the distribution of nursing homes, the number of licensed nursing home beds, and their utilization. The following two charts, derived from Delaware Population Consortium data, provide the context within which to evaluate the availability of facilities for the elderly. Chart 1 shows the projected increase of Delaware's total population from 2010 to 2040. Chart 2 shows the projected population increase over the same time period among Delawareans age 65 and older.

Between 2010 and 2040, Delaware's total population is expected to increase 22 percent. Overall population growth is distributed unevenly across Delaware's counties; from 2010-2040, Kent and Sussex Counties are expected to experience a 23.8 percent and 39.8 percent increase in total population, respectively. Total population growth for New Castle County is estimated at 14.9 percent over the same time period. Projected population growth is much more dramatic among older Delawareans. From 2010 to 2040, the statewide population of Delawareans age 65 and older is expected to increase 99 percent (nearly doubling from 130,301 to 258,905). Among this subpopulation, cohorts of the oldest Delawareans are expected to increase most rapidly in size. Between 2010 and 2040, statewide percentages of residents age 75-79, 80-84, and 85+ are projected to increase 128.9 percent, 149.7 percent, and 188.0 percent, respectively.

**Chart 1: Delaware Population Projections (2010-2040), Overall Population, by County**



## II. FACILITY CHARACTERISTICS

### NUMBER OF NURSING HOME BEDS


In 2012, 47 Delaware nursing homes operated a total of 5,081 licensed beds across the state. The majority of Delaware nursing homes – 44 out of 47 – were privately owned and operated in 2012. Privately-owned licensed beds accounted for 88.7 percent of all licensed nursing home beds in Delaware. Delaware’s three publicly-operated nursing home facilities (Emily P. Bissell Hospital, Governor Bacon Health Center, and the Delaware Hospital for the Chronically Ill) accounted for the remaining 11.3 percent of statewide nursing home beds.

The map on the following page shows the geographic location of Delaware nursing homes. Each circular symbol represents one nursing home. The size of the circular symbol corresponds to the number of licensed beds at that facility. New Castle County is home to 27 private nursing homes and two public nursing homes. Kent County houses six private nursing homes and one public nursing home. The remaining 11 private nursing homes are located in Sussex County.

## UTILIZATION

A commonly-used measure of nursing home utilization is the number of billable patient days generated by a facility over a given time period. A billable patient day represents a unit of time (i.e., one

day) during which the facility’s services are used by one patient. For example, if a nursing home has 100 patients on a particular day, the facility has generated 100 billable patient days for that particular 24-hour period. If a facility’s number of billable patient days increases from one time period to the next, it is an indication that the facility is caring for more patients, caring for patients for longer periods of time, or a combination of these two factors. Mathematically, billable patient days per facility per year are calculated by summing each facility’s monthly billable patient days over a 12-month period.

In 2012, the number of patient days among private nursing homes in New Castle, Kent, and Sussex Counties remained fairly stable compared to the previous year (2011). From 2011 to 2012, the number of patient days in public facilities fell 13.3 percent (from 131,675 to 114,177). Long-term trends reveal sizeable shifts in the number of patient days by county and facility type. From 2002-2012, New Castle County and Sussex County private nursing homes experienced a 5.1 percent and 6.0 percent increase in billable patient days. During the same time period, private nursing homes in Kent County experienced a substantially larger 27.9% increase in billable patient days. From 2002 to 2012, billable patient days among Delaware’s public nursing homes declined 25.6%.

**OCCUPANCY**

Occupancy rates are helpful for putting facilities’ utilization data within the context of available resources. A facility’s occupancy rate reflects the percentage of available beds occupied by patients

during the reporting year. Occupancy rates are weighted based on the number of days a facility was open during the reporting year. Mathematically, for facilities that were open 365 days of the reporting year,

**Weighted Occupancy Rate** = [(Number of Billable Patient Days) / (Number of Licensed Bed Days)] \* 100%, where (Number of Licensed Bed Days) equals the number of licensed beds in a facility (as of December of the reporting year) multiplied by 365. If a facility was open fewer than 365 days of the reporting year, the same weighted occupancy formula is used with the exception that (Number of Licensed Bed Days) equals the number of licensed beds multiplied by the actual number of days the facility was open.

Between 2011 and 2012, the overall occupancy rates for private facilities in New Castle and Sussex Counties remained fairly stable, while the occupancy rate for Kent County private facilities declined from 93.6 percent to 89.5 percent. Public facilities continued to experience a decline in overall occupancy rates from 2011 to 2012. Since 2002, overall occupancy rates for private facilities in all three counties have hovered near 90 percent. Over the past 10 years, the most noticeable decline in occupancy rates has been among public nursing home facilities. From 2002 to 2012, the overall occupancy rate for public facilities fell nearly 10 percent (from 64.2 percent to 54.3 percent).

**ADMISSIONS**

The annual number of admissions to private Delaware nursing homes has steadily increased since 2002; however, increases in the number of admitted patients have been most dramatic in Kent and Sussex

Counties. From 2002-2012, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in Kent and Sussex Counties increased 97.0 percent and 99.4 percent, respectively. Over the same time period, the annual number of admissions to private nursing homes in New Castle County increased 43.2 percent. While private nursing home admissions have steadily increased across all three counties, annual admissions to public nursing homes in Delaware have been more erratic. Since 2002, public nursing homes in Delaware have experienced substantial year-to-year fluctuations in the number of patients admitted each year. Considering the most recent 11 years' worth of data, the peak number of public nursing home admissions occurred in 2006 when 156 patients were admitted to Delaware's three public nursing homes. In 2012, this number fell to just 31 patients. From 2002-2012, public nursing home admissions fell 69.9 percent across Delaware.


As shown in Table 5, white patients accounted for nearly 81 percent of all Delaware nursing home admissions in 2012. Black patients and patients of other races accounted for 17.4 percent and 1.7 percent of 2012 nursing home admissions, respectively. When considering admissions by age category, individuals ages 75-84 and 85 and over accounted for 33.4 percent and 32.5 percent, respectively, of all Delaware nursing home admissions. Just less than one-fifth (19.7 percent) of 2012 nursing home admissions were individuals ages 65-74. The youngest category of nursing home patients – those under age 65 – accounted for the remaining 14.3 percent of 2012 admissions.

Although black patients and patients of other races only accounted for a combined 19.1 percent of all nursing home admissions, the demographic profile of these groups reveals interesting trends in terms of nursing home care across Delaware. When the total numbers of nursing home admissions for whites, blacks, and patients of other races are stratified by age, it becomes clear that blacks and patients of other races who were admitted to nursing home in 2012 represent an overall younger cohort compared to their white counterparts. As shown below in Figure 2, in 2012, just fewer than 12 percent of all white nursing home admissions were individuals under the age of 65. Relative to this, individuals under the age of 65 accounted for 25.3 percent and 25.1 percent of black patients and patients of other races, respectively. Among black patients admitted to Delaware nursing homes in 2012, exactly half were individuals age 74 and under. In summary, while whites account for substantially more nursing home admissions overall, black patients and patients of other races tend to be younger when they are admitted to Delaware nursing homes.

## DISCHARGES

In 2012, Delaware nursing homes discharged a total of 11,417 patients. Over the past 11 years, the number of discharges from private Delaware nursing homes has substantially increased across all three counties. From 2002-2012, Kent and Sussex Counties experienced the greatest increase in the number of annual private nursing home discharges (136.8 percent and 95.6 percent, respectively). Private nursing home discharges increased 35.1 percent in New Castle County over the same time period. Since 2002, Delaware's three public nursing homes experienced a 26.9 percent decline in the number of annual discharges; however, this decline in the number of discharges mirrors a similar decline in the number of annual admissions among Delaware's public nursing homes.

The proportion of Delaware nursing home patients discharged to different destinations varied greatly by facility type. Patients discharged from private facilities were far more likely to return home compared to patients discharged from public facilities (54.1 percent vs. 17.2 percent, respectively). Nearly 60 percent of patients discharged from public nursing home facilities represented discharges due to death. Among discharges from private nursing homes, just fewer than 11 percent represented discharges due to death.


As shown in Table 8, white patients accounted for 81 percent of all Delaware nursing home discharges in 2012. Black patients and patients of other races accounted for 17.3 percent and 1.6 percent of 2012 nursing home discharges, respectively. When considering discharges by age category, individuals ages 75-84 and 85 and over accounted for 32.7 percent and 34.1 percent, respectively, of all Delaware nursing home discharges. Just less than one-fifth (19.2 percent) of 2012 nursing home discharges were individuals ages 65-74. The youngest category of nursing home patients – those under age 65 – accounted for the remaining 14.0 percent of 2012 discharges.

The age breakdown among white, black, and other race patients discharged from Delaware nursing homes in 2012 is similar to that among nursing home admissions. Black patients and patients of other races discharged from Delaware nursing homes represent and overall younger population. Over one-quarter of black patients and patients of other races discharged from nursing homes were under the age of 65. Only 11.3 percent of white patients discharged from Delaware nursing homes fell into this youngest age category. In summary, while whites account for substantially more nursing home discharges overall, black patients and patients of other races discharged from Delaware nursing homes represent a younger population in general.

**SOURCE OF PAYMENT**

Patient payment for nursing home care varies by type of facility. The overwhelming majority (81.2 percent) of patients in public Delaware nursing homes used Medicaid as a source of payment; among patients at private Delaware nursing homes, just over 55 percent paid by way of Medicaid. Although the percentage of private nursing home patients using Medicare has increased slowly since 2002, Medicare is still not a major payer of nursing home care in Delaware. In 2012, 18.8 percent and 0.3 percent of patients in private and public nursing homes, respectively, used Medicare as their source of payment. Just over one-fifth (21.0 percent) of private nursing home patients self-paid for their care, compared to 13.1 percent of public nursing home patients. Finally, approximately 5 percent of patients in both public and private nursing homes used a different source of payment for their care.
