
Delaware Weekly Influenza Report

MMWR Week 42 (October 16, 2022 to October 22, 2022)

Influenza-Like-Illness Activity Estimates: Minimal*

During MMWR week 42, there were **44** laboratory-confirmed cases of influenza reported among Delaware residents with **69** total cases for the 2022-2023 season, so far. Reports of influenza-like-illness (ILI)¹ received from participating providers, facilities, and institutions² in Delaware show the ILI rate is at **1.37%** which is **below** Delaware's 2022-2023 baseline rate of 2.0%. Nationally, **3.3%** visits to a health care provider were for ILI, which is **above** the 2022-2023 national baseline of 2.5%.

- 10 influenza-related hospitalizations since October 2, 2022
- **0** influenza-related deaths since October 2, 2022
- 98 positive Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) tests for MMWR week 42
- 250 positive Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) tests for season total





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

¹Influenza-like illness (ILI) is defined as patients presenting with fever of 100° F or greater, cough, and/or sore throat without a known cause other than influenza. Rates are number ILI visits out of all patients seen at the facility.
