

In order to accomplish its mission and objectives, the Division of State Service Centers (DSSC) administers a number of programs and services. The goal of the centers is to promote access to Delaware's health and human service system by providing a mix of services appropriate to the community they serve. There are more than 160 programs and services delivered through the Division. Annually, more than 450,000 visits are made to service centers throughout Delaware. Division programs include the Office of Community Services (OCS), the Office of Family Support Services (FSS) and the State Office of Volunteerism (SOV). The Division also publishes the *Directory of Human Services for Delaware*.

The Office of Community Services administers the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), the Community Service Block Grant (CSBG), emergency and transitional housing, emergency food distribution, taxpayer donations to the Emergency Housing Assistance Fund, the Family Visitation Centers, and the Adopt-A-Family Program.

The Office of Family Support Services manages crisis intervention assistance services statewide through the 15 State Service Centers. Services include: Emergency Assistance Services, the Diabetes Medical Fund, the Needy Family Fund, the Utility Fund, Repatriation Assistance, the Kinship Care Program, the Teen Voucher Program, and the Community Resource Assistance Services Program.

The State Office of Volunteerism offers both volunteer and service opportunities, provides technical assistance for community volunteer programs, and sponsors volunteer recognition events. SOV programs include AmeriCorps, Foster Grandparents, the Retired Senior Volunteer Program, and the State Volunteer Resource Center. SOV operates in partnership with the Governor's Commission on Community and Volunteer Service.
