The Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health (DSAMH) is seeking to contract with one or more psychiatrists with the qualifications and clinical skills necessary to provide psychiatric services to persons with a psychiatric disability who are under the care of DSAMH's outpatient Community Mental Health Centers (individual clinics are located in Wilmington with a need of 16 hours per week and Georgetown with a need of 16 hours per week). Applicants must be eligible for licensure in Delaware and be Board Certified or Board Eligible and have an NPI number. Resumes must be sent under cover of a brief letter of interest specifying preferred service location, days/hours of availability and proposed hourly rate and must reference RFP PSC-0746. Applications will be accepted from individual applicants, group practices and partnerships. Determination of qualified applicants will be based on a review of credentials and experience. Selection of applicant(s) will be made by the Division Director following interview of one or more qualified applicants.
