Extra Emergency Food Benefits end and your monthly Food Benefit amount will return to normal.

What do you need to do?

You do not need to take any action. You have been getting extra Emergency Food Benefits at the end of each month during the COVID-19 public health emergency. A federal law was passed that ends Emergency Food Benefits. Your regular monthly Food Benefits will continue until the end of your approval period as long as you remain eligible.
