APPLICATION TO BECOME A DELAWARE CERTIFIED NURSE AIDE FOR RN OR LPN GRADUATE

- Individuals who have graduated from an RN or LPN program in the United States more than twenty-four (24) months prior to application for certification. These individuals are deemed qualified to meet the Delaware approved nurse aide training program requirements and are eligible to take the Delaware State Nurse Aide Competency Exam. These candidates must submit a sealed copy of their school diploma along with their application.
- Individuals who have graduated from an RN or LPN program in the United States less that twenty-four (24) months prior to application for certification are deemed qualified to meet the Delaware approved nurse aide training programs requirements and competency evaluation program requirements and are eligible for certification upon submission of a sealed copy of their diploma.
