<u>NOTE</u>: The data provided may not be a true reflection of the total number of people who have been infected with influenza virus in Delaware, chiefly due to the following:

- Many people ill with influenza-like symptoms do not seek medical care; and
- Many who do seek medical care are not tested for influenza.

Level of *Influenza* Activity in Delaware, Week 15, 2012:


Sporadic

- ➡ : Isolated laboratory confirmed cases <u>OR</u> a laboratory confirmed outbreak in one institution but no increase in reports of ILI from the regional baseline for the season.
- **▶** Influenza-like illness (ILI) is defined as patients presenting with fever over 100° F, cough and/or sore throat in the absence of a known cause other than influenza.
- No Activity: No laboratory confirmed cases of *influenza* and no increase in the number of reports of ILI above regional baseline for the season.
- **▶** Sporadic: Isolated laboratory confirmed cases <u>OR</u> a laboratory confirmed outbreak in one institution but no increase in reports of ILI from the regional baseline for the season.
- Local: Increased ILI above the regional baseline for the season in a single county; ILI activity in other counties is not increased above baseline AND recent (within the past three weeks) laboratory evidence of *influenza* in the county with increased ILI <u>OR</u> two or more institutional outbreaks (ILI or laboratory confirmed flu) in a single county AND recent (within the past three weeks) laboratory evidence of *influenza* in the county with the outbreaks; virus activity is no greater than sporadic in other counties.
- ▶ Regional: Outbreaks of *influenza* or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed *influenza* in at least 2 but less than half the regions of the state. (This level of activity does not apply for small states with 4 or fewer regions.)
- **Widespread**: Increase in ILI reports above the regional baseline and/or institutional outbreaks of influenza (ILI or lab confirmed) AND recent (within the past 3 weeks) laboratory confirmed *influenza* in at least two of the three counties.

ILINet (Sentinel) Provider Surveillance Network:


ILINet providers conduct surveillance for ILI in collaboration with the Division of Public Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Data reported by ILINet providers, in combination with other *influenza* surveillance data, provide a national and statewide picture of *influenza* virus and ILI activity in the U.S.

Influenza-like illness reported from ILINet Providers Delaware, 2011-2012 8 of 15 Sentinel Providers reporting






Hospital Manual Surveillance ILI Data: Delaware, 2011-2012 Nanticoke Hospital Reporting




Influenza-like illness reported from Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs): Delaware 2011-2012

Two of two FQHCs reporting (La Red Health Center & Henrietta Johnson Medical Center)




Influenza-like-illness reported by Long-Term Care Facilities (LTCFs): Delaware, 2011-2012 11 of 20 facilities reporting




Influenza-like illness reported by Colleges/Universities: Delaware, 2011-2012


