



TIER 3 SHELTER MEDICAL STATION

What are Tier 3 Shelter Medical Stations?	The Tier 3 Shelter Medical Station provides safe and temporary housing to individuals who require support with their medical needs. These shelters are available for people who cannot be accommodated in a regular shelter. They provide a higher level of medical support than regular public shelters (e.g., Red Cross Shelters).
What conditions can I expect there?	Individuals receive sleeping accommodations and food. Trained medical staff assist with medical needs. Shelters do not provide convenience or luxury items.
Who should go to a Tier 3 Shelter Medical Station?	People with minor medical conditions who are stable and require daily assistance to meet their medical needs will qualify. Examples: assistance with medication administration or daily living activities, changing wound dressings, or helping the oxygen dependent.
Who should <i>not</i> go to a Tier 3 Shelter Medical Station?	People with unstable medical conditions are not suitable for a Tier 3 Shelter Medical Station. They are best taken care of at a hospital. Speak to your doctor to determine if you are suitable for a Tier 3 Shelter Medical Station.
Location of shelters:	Delawareans will be advised through local news media of the location of the Tier 3 Shelter Medical Station.
Can I bring my pets?	Only service animals are allowed in the Tier 3 Shelter Medical Station.
What should I bring with me to the shelter?	Your caregiver(s) should come with you to the shelter. Bring these items: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Durable medical equipment such as walkers and oxygen tanks• All medications and supplies• Personal items• Any special dietary items• Important documents (insurance information) and phone numbers.
What should I <i>not</i> bring to the shelter?	Weapons, alcoholic beverages, and illegal drugs are not permitted in the shelter.
