

# Ebola Quick Screening Tool

## for Outpatient Practices

In the past 21 days, have you...

- a. Been in **Guinea, Liberia, Sierra Leone, Congo, Nigeria, Senegal**, or
- b. Had contact with an individual you know or suspect might have **Ebola** (in West Africa, the United States, or elsewhere).

Have you had, or do you currently have, any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (greater than 38°C or 100.4°F)
- Severe headache
- Muscle pain
- Weakness
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Abdominal (stomach) pain
- Unexplained hemorrhage (bleeding or bruising)

It's okay for the patient to sit in the common waiting area. Treat as with any regular patient.

It's okay for the patient to sit in the common waiting area. Treat as you would any regular patient. Use standard precautions and proper hand hygiene, as you would with any patient.

Obtain patient's contact information for a follow up call from the Division of Public Health (DPH). Call DPH with any reported exposure at **888-295-5156**.

Move to an area separate from other patients. Staff are to use personal protective equipment (PPE), and call 9-1-1 for patient transport.
