 Subcommittee to vote on recommendation to DEFAC for DEFAC's approval as to whether the forecasted PGSP growth rate has changed in such a material way that it warrants a change in the spending benchmark



Purpose of the Subcommittee

Executive Order 25, Section 3

- a. Each year through 2023, review and recommend whether the forecasted PGSP growth rate has changed in such a material way that it warrants a change in the spending benchmark
- b. After 2023, evaluate the results of PGSP benchmark and methodology, and recommend any appropriate changes
- c. Provide the public and interested stakeholders an opportunity to provide input and consider their recommendations
- d. Advise the Governor and DEFAC on current and projected trends in health care and the health care industry, as they affect the expenditures and revenues of the State, its citizens, and industries
