What is the Delaware State Loan Repayment Program (SLRP)?

The Delaware SLRP is designed to recruit health professionals to underserved areas of the State. In exchange for a two-year commitment to serve in a public or non-profit facility located in a Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA), Delaware will help repay your qualifying education loans.

What is a HPSA & Where Are They Located?

HPSAs are Federally-designated Health Professional Shortage Areas. To qualify for loan repayment, the facility in which you serve must be located in a HPSA. To determine HPSA status, visit http://hpsafind.hrsa.gov/ and search for an area, facility, or enter the site address.
