- HCC worked with DSAMH to submit a proposal in response to SAMHSA's FOA for the **Promoting Integration of Primary and Behavioral Health Care**

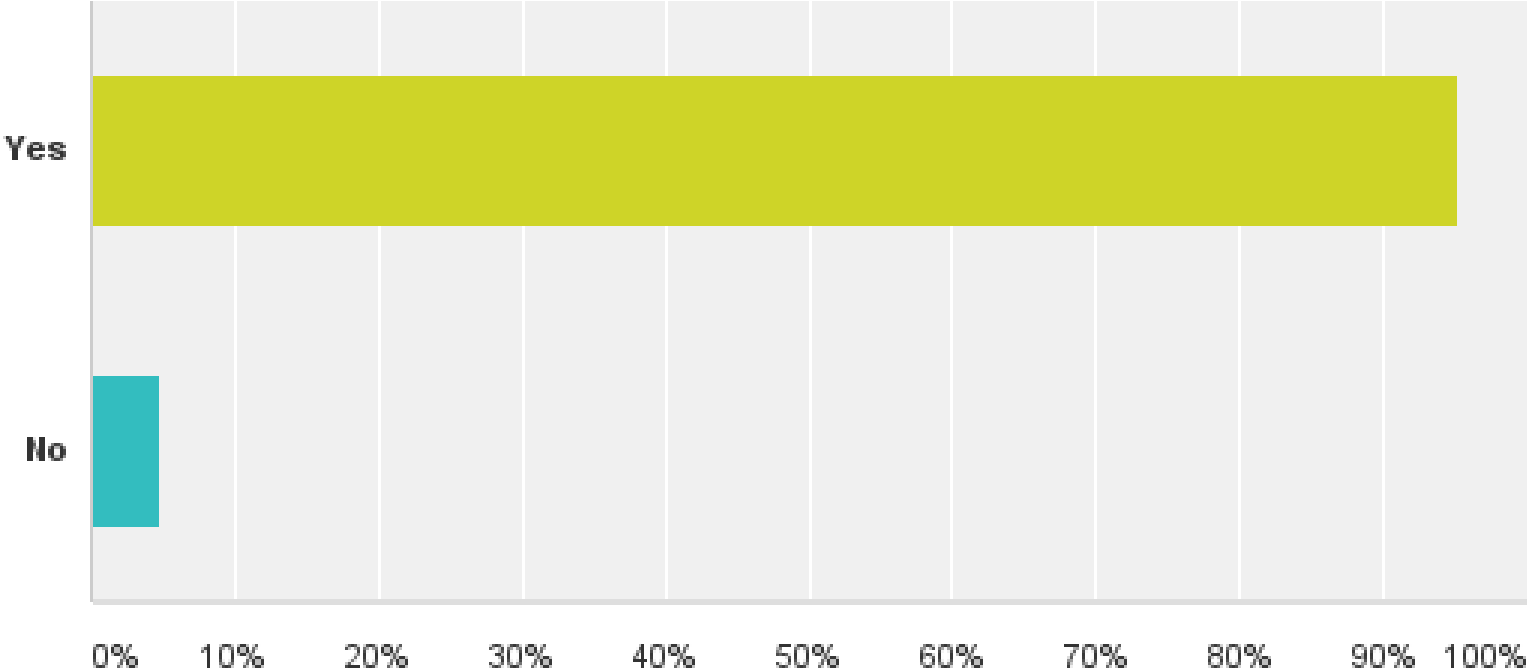

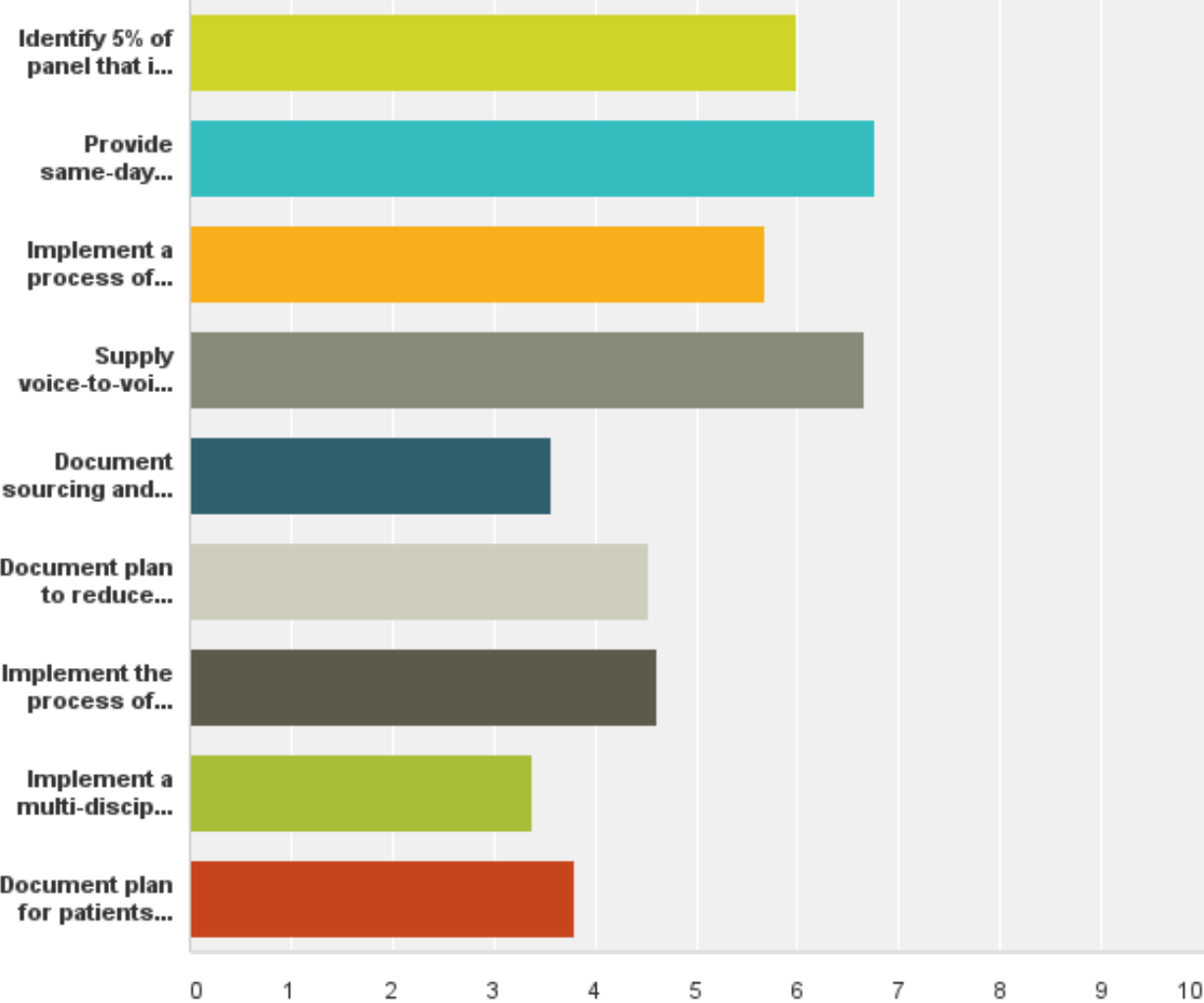

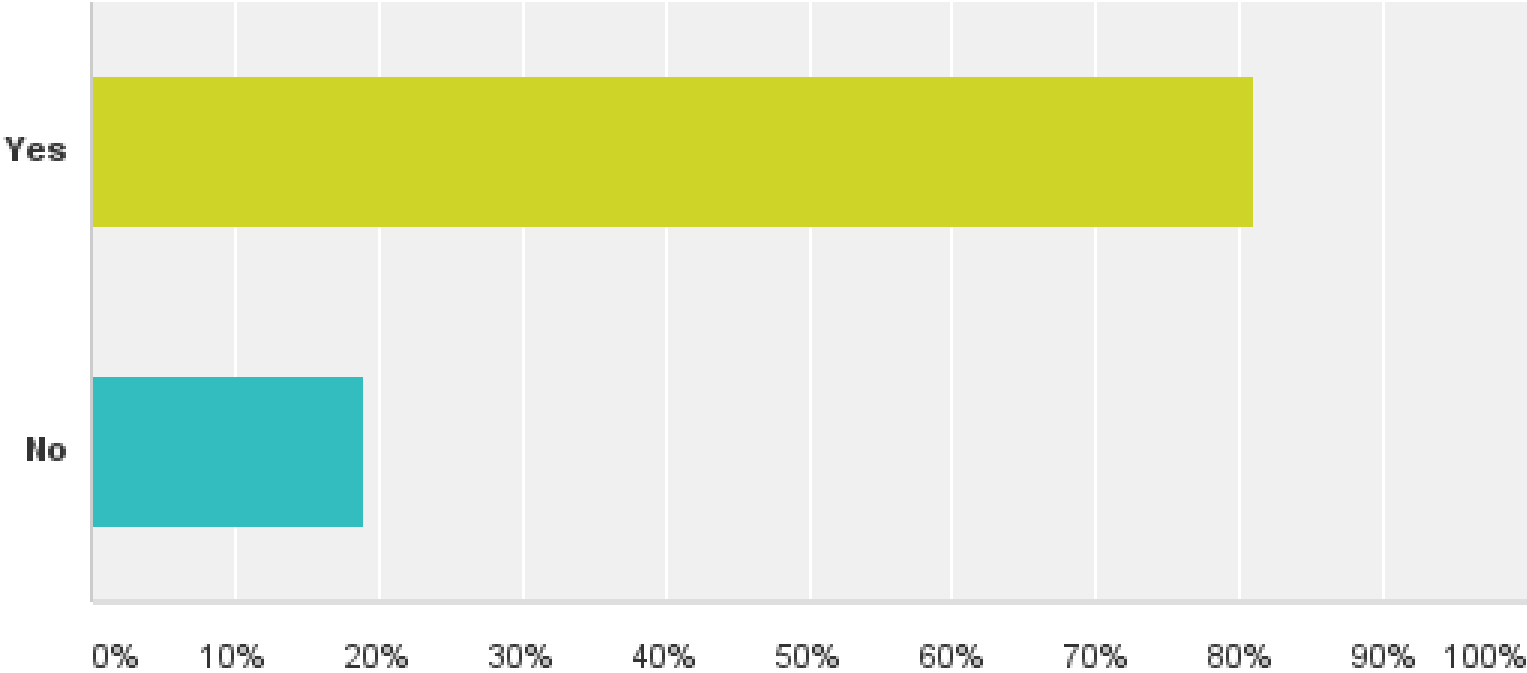

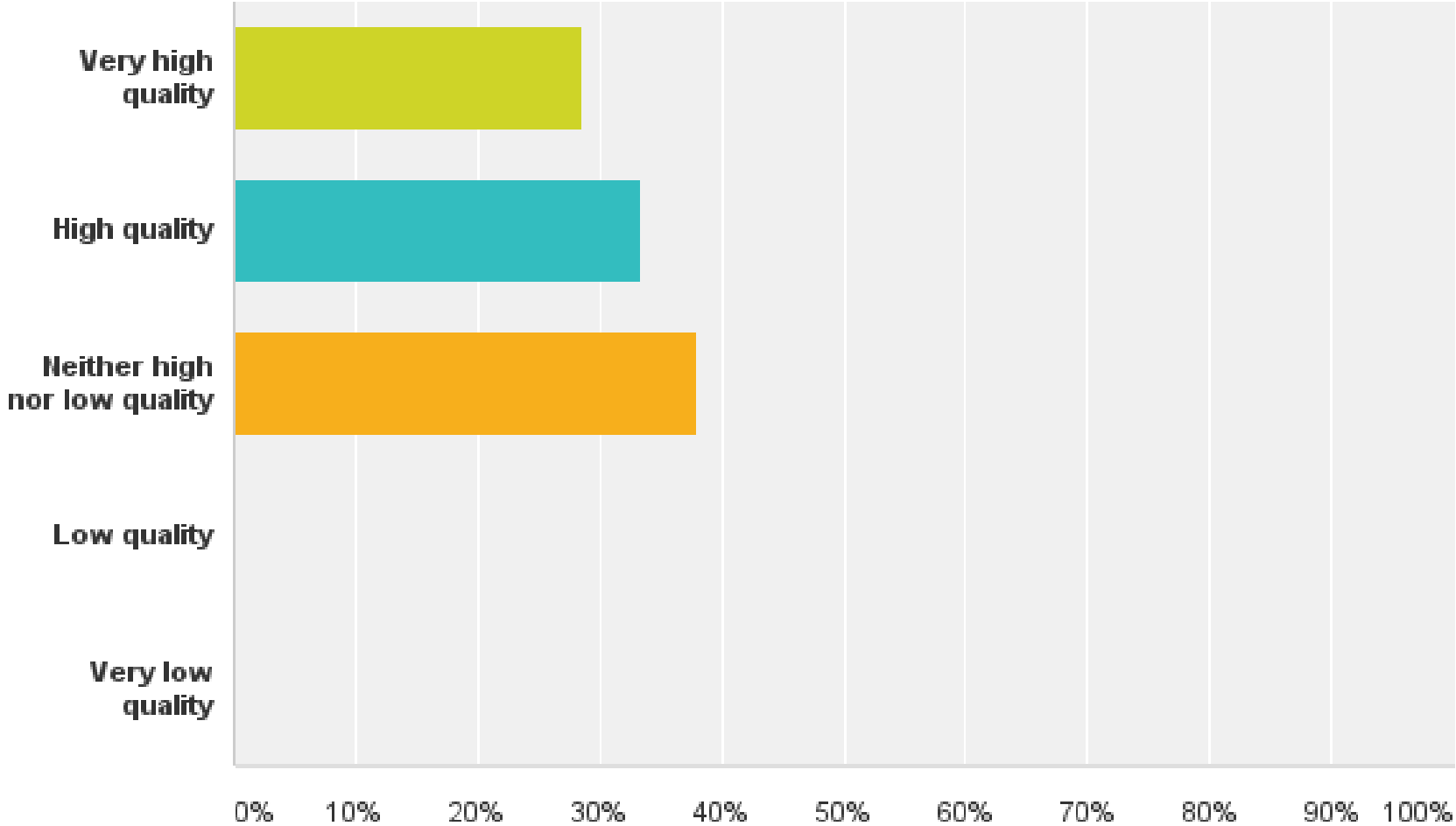

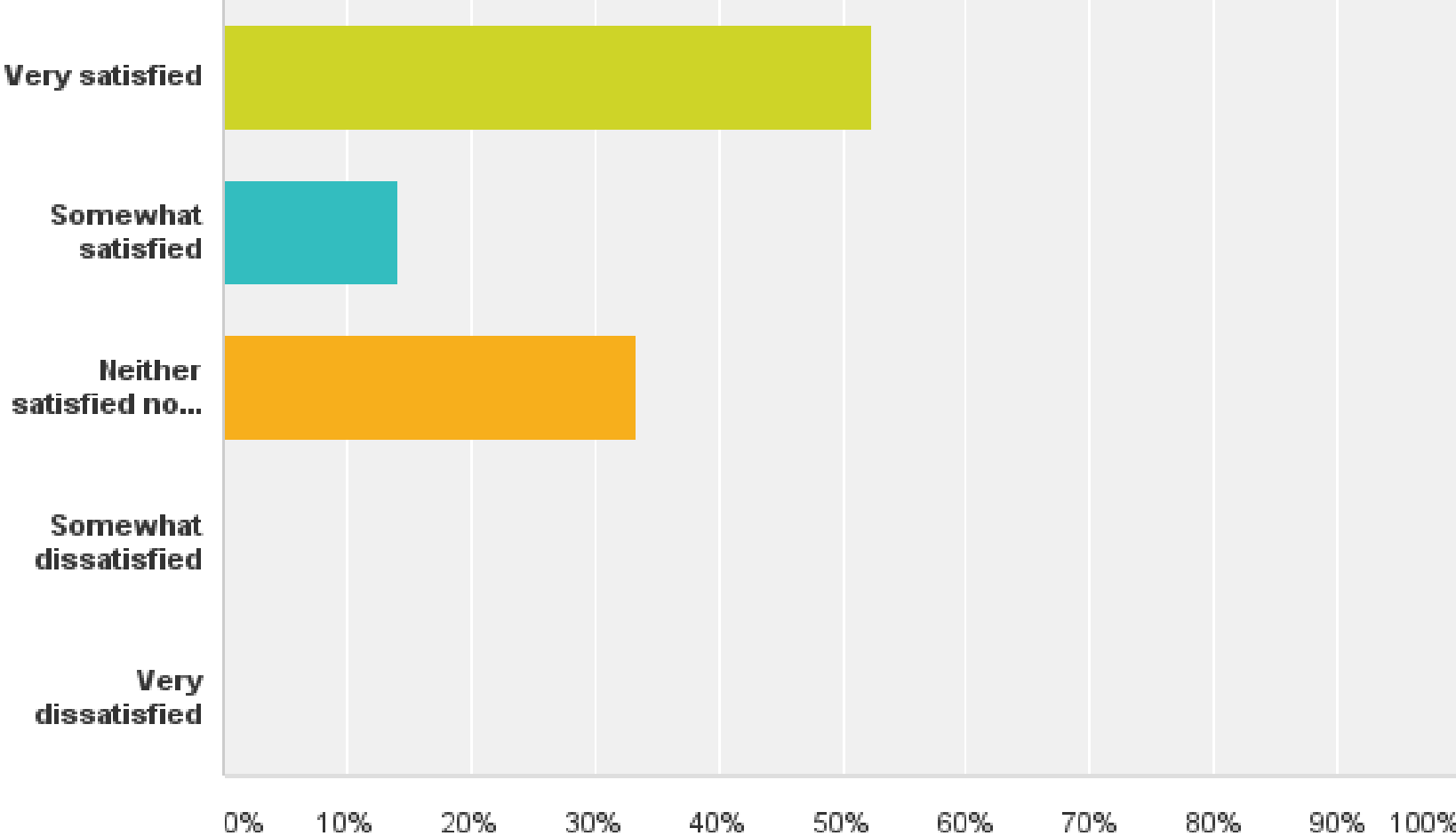
# How would you rate the quality of the services provided by your practice transformation vendor?

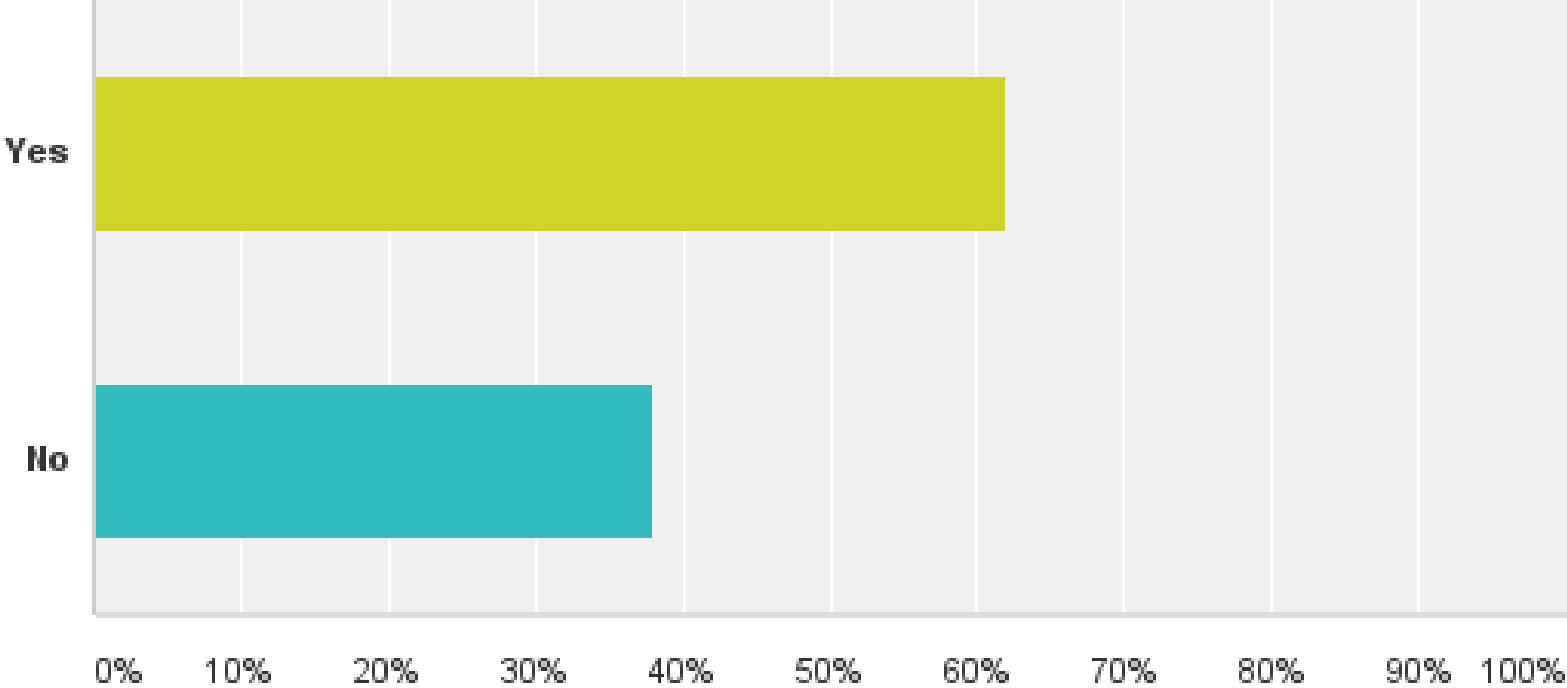


# Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with your practice transformation vendor?
