Two members of the Senate to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, 1 of which must be a member of the Minority Caucus. 11 Del. C. §787(k)(1)(n)
A representative of the Department of Transportation to be appointed by the Secretary of the 39 Department of Transportation. 11 Del. C. §787(k)(1)(o)
A representative from the Criminal Justice Council to be appointed by the Executive Director of the Criminal Justice Council. 11 Del. C. §787(k)(1)(p)
A person who has been a victim of human trafficking to be appointed by the Governor for a 3-year term and shall be eligible for reappointment. 11 Del. C. §787(k)(1)(q)
The Council may include a resident of any county who has prior experience in working with victims of human trafficking in a legal or advocacy capacity. 11 Del. C. §787(k)(1)(r)

C. § 787, the Delaware Human Trafficking Interagency Coordinating Council is charged with developing plans, collecting and evaluating data, and coordinating State agencies to provide services for victims of human trafficking.
