### **IHER Program Areas**

#### Research Capacity Core

- Supports existing research resources such as DSU's research support facilities in microscopy, cell electrophysiology and DNA sequencing.
- Establishes a new Qualitative Research & Evaluation Core to support health disparities research particularly community engaged research.
- Links with Biostats, Epidemiology, Research Design Core of ACCEL
- Funds research laboratory renovations

#### **Investigator Development Core**

Supports a pilot program of health disaprities research grants \$50,000/year for 2 years - 2 rounds of 5 grants will be awarded

#### **Recruitment Core**

- Supports hiring of faculty with a focus on health disparities research
- 2 mid-career, 1 junior
- Salary + start-up support for research
