- Wide variation in Milestone Pass Rates by vendor (especially M5, M8, and M9)
- Each vendor has at least two Milestones for which the Pass Rate is 90.0% or greater
- V4: 95.0% of enrolled practices are passing each Milestone
- Milestones with **highest** avg. Pass Rates: M3 (avg. Pass Rate: 90.4%), M4 (avg. Pass Rate: 92.5%)
- Milestones with **lowest** avg. Pass Rate: M8 (avg. Pass Rate: 40.3%), M9 (avg. Pass Rate: 43.2%)
