

# How does Delaware health care rate in quality measures?

A recent report offers insight into Delaware's performance.

This report reflects the Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) results collected by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA). The measures shown in the chart are reported to the NCQA by commercial health plans to help determine the effectiveness of care. In Delaware, the plans reporting on these common quality measures include UnitedHealthcare, Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company, Highmark Blue Cross and Blue Shield, Aetna Health, and Optimum Choice. No measure should be interpreted in isolation. Measures are best understood in the context of other measures. Examining data patterns can provide a more complete picture of performance.
