- HCC worked with DSAMH to submit a proposal in response to SAMHSA's FOA for the Promoting Integration of Primary and Behavioral Health Care



Workforce Learning & Relearning Curriculum	 74 people enrolled in the curriculum to date Module 2 in-person session will be held on June 7



Are you familiar with the milestones and sub-criteria you are working to achieve for the project?






Practice Transformation Participant Survey, May 12-30, 2017 N = 21

Do you see improved care and patient outcomes due to your practice transformation work?




How would you rate the quality of the services provided by your practice transformation vendor?




Practice Transformation Participant Survey, May 12-30, 2017 N = 21
