HCC SIM Grant Management Update

- **Quarterly Progress Report** submitted to CMMI on Nov. 30
 - Once approved, narrative will be available on HCC website and financial report provided to HCC
- **Year 3 Operational Plan** submitted on Dec. 1; awaiting CMMI approval
 - Once approved, will be available on HCC website and deeper dive provided to HCC
 - Award Year 3 scheduled to begin Feb. 1
- Transition away from intense **consultant support in Year 3**
 - Will maintain strategic counsel from McKinsey & Co.
 - PCG will provide support to HCC for grant management and reporting

Program Area and DCHI Updates

- The DCHI Board approved its **strategic plan** at its Dec. board meeting; tactical planning for each recommendation will begin in Q1 2017
- DCHI Board **approved committee chairs and Board members**; voting on officers in January
- Progress is being made on a variety of initiatives:
 - 54 providers enrolled in the **Common Scorecard** since statewide launch in October
 - 340 providers (in 98 practices) currently enrolled in **Practice Transformation** services
 - Highmark and United launched **value-based payment models** beginning January 1
 - Funding approved for **BH EMR Assistance Program**; winning bidders from Rounds 1 and 2 of RFP are being finalized
