Operational Plan

- The SIM Operational Plan for 2016 is being finalized for submission to CMMI; expect approval by January 31
- Major components of the Operational Plan include:
 - Revised timeline, budget summary and core progress metrics
 - Detailed operational plan across SIM program areas

Program Evaluation

- Vendor for state-led evaluation of SIM program is being selected through procurement process
- Evaluator will track implementation milestones and outcomes, and ensure the state meets program goals

Health Workforce

- RFP for Graduate Health Professionals Consortium and Health Care Workforce Learning and Re-Learning Curriculum will be released on January 15

Summary of December DCHI Board meeting

- DCHI Executive Director updated Board on progress made towards DCHI startup and infrastructure requirements
- Board voted to renew all committee rosters for 2016
- Board discussed committee operating procedures and opportunities to improve consistency in 2016
- Discussed Consensus Paper on Integration of Behavioral Health and Primary Care
 - Board asked to review paper and provide feedback
 - Final draft of paper will be brought to the Board in January 2016 for discussion and approval
- Reviewed overall program dashboard
 - Board asked to provide feedback on metrics including provider satisfaction, workforce availability, and consumer engagement
 - Committees will provide final input on measures, to be approved by board in January 2016




Recent DCHI focus areas
