- As of 4/20, there are 28 different providers submitting EVV visit data to the Sandata aggregator for a total of 107,917 individual visits.
  - 80,555 of the 107,917 visits are in a verified status
  - Providers who are using alternate EVV systems must review their visit data in the Sandata aggregator and confirm verified status

- Alt EVV Providers have been receiving the following error:
  Error reads: ERROR: Client Not Found. Clients must have been previously received from Payer on an authorization to be updated via Alt-EVV.
- There are two known issues that could be causing some members to not show up in the mobile app or the aggregator for Sandata users.
  - Some payer/program/procedure code/modifiers were either incorrect or not included in the initial Sandata load
    - It is anticipated that these additions/corrections will be deployed as part of Sandata's May 17 release
  - The logic for the member file from DMES did not include individuals with retroactive or prospective eligibility.
    - This file is being modified to capture these individuals although date of implementation of new file layout is not known at this time.

- Please provide specific examples for us to research to determine if this error is a result of two issues we are aware of or if the cause is something new.
- Note that any information sent that contains individual's PII must be sent in a secure manner.

- There is a delay with Delaware First Health joining EVV.
  - Initially targeted for May 1, 2023.
  - The State will announce the new date by which providers contracted with Delaware First Health may submit their visit data.

#### MCDID Selection

- The State is finalizing guidance related to the selection and use of MCDIDs.
- This will be shared as soon as it is finalized.
- Key is provider's completion of their 21st Century Cures Act clean-up.

#### Identifying Member Medicaid Identifier

Providers must use the member's Medicaid ID (MID) as the identifier in the Sandata EVV system. This number is also a required data element in the alternate EVV vendor visit file. Providers can obtain this number in a variety of ways:

- Members Medicaid/MCO Card The member's Medicaid/MCO card will contain both the MCO-assigned ID and the MID.
- Call the Automated Voice Response System (AVRS) Call 1.800.999.3371 option 1. The following will be needed for the call:
  - NPI
  - PIN (last 4 of Tax ID or SSN if individual)
  - Taxonomy
  - Zip Code that matches what is in DMES
- Contact the MCO with whom the member is enrolled


#### Identifying Member Medicaid Identifier

- Search on the DMES provider portal In order to use the portal, providers must first register.
  - Register using your MCDID and PIN (last 4 of Tax ID or SSN if individual).
    Once registered, providers have access to the secure portal where eligibility can be verified.
  - Providers can also create delegates to work on their behalf. Delegate access can be limited to verifying eligibility only. Each delegate would register with their own account based on the delegate account created by the provider.

#### Sandata on Demand


- What is Sandata On Demand?
