### **Project Updates**

- EVV Statistics as of 9/16
  - A total of 39 providers using 51-distinct MCDIDs are submitting visits to Sandata
  - 132 discreet MCDIDS are registered with Sandata
  - 278,736 visits have been submitted to Sandata with 237,023 (85%) in a verified status

### **Project Updates**


- Fewer than half of all registered providers are submitting visits
  - If you need help and plan to use Sandata, email <u>decustomercare@sandata.com</u>.
  - If you need help and use an alternate EVV system email <u>DEaltevv@sandata.com</u> and put "DE ALT EVV" in the subject line.

### **Common Pitfalls**

- Providers have not registered the MCDID for which the MCOs are sending authorizations
  - All MCDIDs used for services applicable to EVV must be registered with Sandata
  - Many providers have more than one MCDID. DMMA, Mercer, Gainwell and the MCOs have been reaching out to providers to help align
  - All partners have encountered some level of issues while implementing required follow-up actions. This delayed progress; however, some issues have been or continue to be addressed

### **Common Pitfalls**

- It is critical that the MCDIDs registered with Sandata are the same MCDIDs that the MCOs are using on prior authorizations
  - The MCOs send a PA file to Sandata and this is the mechanism to match members, providers and MCOs
  - In order for a provider to "see" a client in the Sandata aggregator the MCO must have submitted an authorization for that client's Medicaid ID under the MCDID that the provider registered
  - If using a 3<sup>rd</sup> party EVV solution, visits submitted for clients without authorizations or for clients with the wrong MCDID will receive an error message
- Providers using Alternate EVV vendors must make sure that the vendor is sending visits to the correct MCDID
- Sandata does not submit claims. You must continue sending claims to the appropriate payer



# Schedule

- ACDE and HHO will begin post-payment validation in the fall.
  - If there is any issue with matching a visit with a claim, the MCO will outreach the provider and provide education regarding the issue and how to avoid the issue in the future.

#### No claim will be denied for lack of visit verification until January 2025

• The expectation is that issues will be identified and addressed, and all providers will be comfortable and adept at using EVV prior to the hard edit.

# Schedule

- Delaware First Health (DEFH) will begin pre-payment validation in the fall (date TBD)
  - If there is any issue with matching a visit with a claim, DEFH will outreach providers and provide education regarding issues and remediation.
  - DEFH will not deny payment for lack of visit verification until January 2025
- Delaware EVV program is here! All providers should be registered with Sandata, collecting visit data, and, if using an alternate EVV vendor, submitting visit data.

### Schedule
