

PREMIUM REQUIREMENTS

Monthly premiums will be charged to anyone with countable income exceeding 100% of the federal Poverty Level.

Percentage of FPL	Monthly Premium Amount
Up to 100%	\$0
>100% - 125%	\$25
>125% - 150%	\$35
>150% - 175%	\$45
>175% - 200%	\$60
>200% - 225%	\$75
>225% - 250%	\$90
>250% - 275%	\$105

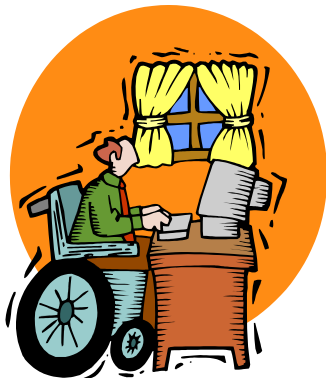


WHAT IS MEDICAID FOR WORKERS WITH DISABILITIES?

The Medicaid for Workers with Disabilities Program will assist individuals with disabilities by allowing them to work without losing health benefits provided by the Medicaid program.

Authorization for this program is found in the following federal legislation:

The Ticket to Work and Work Incentives Act of 1999 (TWWIA)



ELIGIBILITY

An applicant must meet certain criteria in order to be eligible for Medicaid for Workers with Disabilities.

Age

Must be between 16 and 64 years of age

Disability

Must have a disability as defined by the Social Security Administration

Employment

Must be engaged in paid employment

May be full or part time

Must be paying FICA

Income Limits

Unearned Income must be at or below \$956.00/monthly

Earned income can not exceed 275% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).

Standard disregards are applied to earned income in order to obtain countable income amount:

- \$20 disregard
- \$65 disregard
- ½ of the remainder

Spousal income is considered when determining eligibility.
