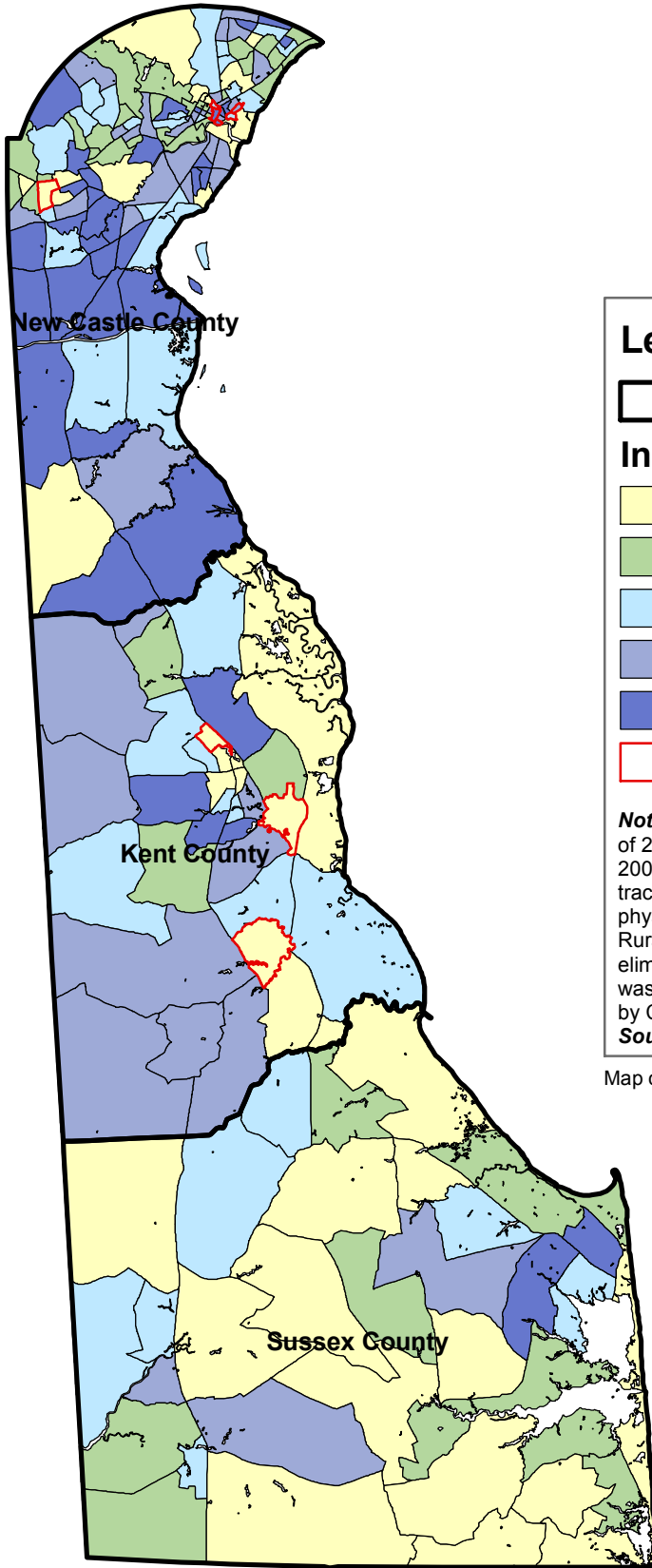



Five-year Age-adjusted Cancer Incidence Rates Delaware Census Tracts, 2001-2005






Note: Census tracts were accurately assigned to 96.5% of 22,023 cancer cases diagnosed in Delaware between 2001 and 2005. For the remaining 3.5% of cases, census tract assignment was impossible due to missing or non-physical address information (for example, P.O. Box and Rural Route addresses).
