1.	The facility provides supplies necessary for adherence to hand hygiene (e.g., soak, water, paper towels, alcohol-based hand rub) and ensures they are readily accessible to HCP patient care areas.					
2.	HCP are educated regarding appropriate indications for hand washing with soap and water versus hand rubbing with alcohol-based hand rub.					
3.	Upon interviewing, staff are knowledgeable about hand hygiene when working with patients with <i>C.Diff.</i> , Norovirus, Scabies or other infectious diseases.					
	Note: Soap and water should be used when bare hands are visibly soiled (e.g., blood, body fluids) or after caring for a patient with known or suspected infectious diarrhea (e.g., Clostridium difficle or norovirus). In all other situations, alcohol-based hand rub may be used
