SUPPORT AND GUIDANCE FOR DELAWARE FAMILIES

The Delaware Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) and Center on Addiction I Partnership for Drug-Free Kids, the nation's leading nonprofit **dedicated to transforming the way the United States addresses addiction**, are collaborating to bring dedicated, science-based resources and support to Delaware families.

In 2017, **Delaware ranked sixth in the nation in drug overdose death rates**, with most of these deaths directly linked to opioids, including heroin, prescription opioids and fentanyl, a synthetic opioid that is 50 times more powerful than heroin. Last year alone, **Delaware lost over 400 lives to overdose**, marking an increase of 16% in overdose deaths from 2017—and almost 3 in 4 of those deaths involved fentanyl.

Through this collaboration, we aim to be a vital part of an integrated solution to affect statewide change. The two entities will work together to provide digital resources and one-on-one support to parents and caregivers as they help a loved one struggling with opioids or other substances.
