START (Substance Use Treatment and Recovery Transformation) is an evidence-based model that transforms Delaware's substance use disorder system of care into one that is personalized and easier to navigate. START accepts people at multiple entry points and follows them through the entire treatment process, facilitating referrals to community resources and ongoing care. Peer support specialists are the treatment gateway guides. They discuss next steps, ensure the individual gets to the chosen treatment facility, and act as a perpetual lifeline. These specialists also help the individual find financial resources, a place to live, and employment — all while being available as a life coach during trying situations. START is where personalized care for substance use disorders is interconnected, from start to finish. We make the best life possible.




