Training Schedule/Production Credentials

CG Modifier

- Informational modifier assigned to claims with procedure codes that are typically subject to EVV to indicate that the service is not subject to EVV per DMMA policy.
 - Reasons include:
 - Services provided by a paid caregiver who lives with the individual
 - Services provided in a location outside of the home (e.g. school)
 - Services provided as part of the hospice benefit when the individual is enrolled in hospice
 - Services provided to a newborn who does not yet have their own Medicaid ID number
 - Services provided out of state.

Rounding Rules

Visits for services where unit of service is 15 minutes

Number of Units	Minutes of Service
1 unit	1 to 23 minutes
2 units	24 to 38 minutes
3 units	39 to 53 minutes
4 units	54 to 68 minutes
5 units	69 to 83 minutes
6 units	84 to 98 minutes
7 units	99 to 113 minutes
8 units	114 to 128 minutes

Visits for services where unit of service is 1 hour

Number of Units	Minutes of Service
1 unit	0-60 minutes
2 units	61-120 minutes
3 units	121-180 minutes
4 units	181-240 minutes

Manual and Modified Visits

Manual Visit Entry

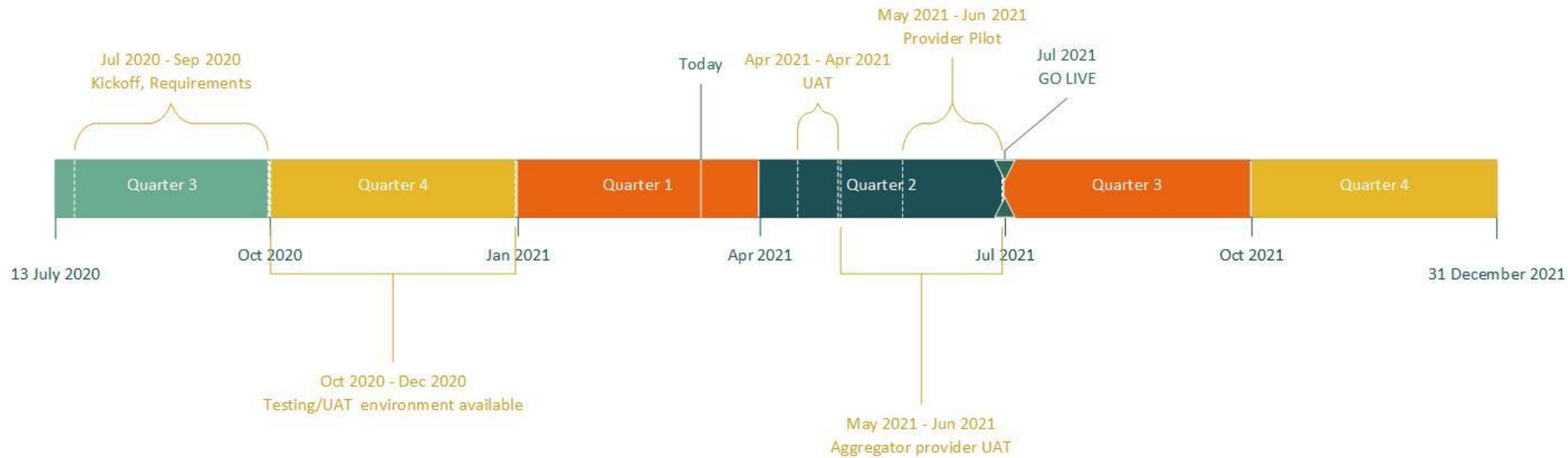
- Means an EVV record input after the time of service delivery by administratively entering the required EVV data elements
- Supporting documentation must be maintained for visits that are entered manually in the EVV system
- Manual entry of visits cannot exceed 10% of a provider's total EVV visits

Modified/Edited Visits

- Visits that are modified/edited in an EVV record after the time of service delivery
- An exception to normal practice
- Supporting documentation must be maintained for any changes to visit information after a visit has been confirmed
- Modified or edited visits are considered to be manually modified and cannot exceed 10% of a provider's total EVV visits

User Acceptance Testing (UAT)

- Testing will begin in April.
- All major AuthentiCare user groups will participate in testing, including a provider with a third-party system that will use the AuthentiCare aggregator.
