WHO WE ARE

The Delaware Health Resources Board was established under Delaware state law ([16 Del. C. § 9303](#)) to foster the cost-effective and efficient use of health-care resources and the availability of and access to high quality and appropriate health-care services. The Board consists of a Chair, a Vice Chair, and 13 members, each appointed to a three-year term by the Governor. A current list of the Board membership is available online:

The Board needs new members. There are currently **five vacant positions** on the Board, and we are looking for individuals who would like to join.

WHO QUALIFIES TO BE A BOARD MEMBER

Delaware law specifies that the Board be made up of select individuals that are representative of all counties in the State. Currently, we need candidates to fill the vacancies designated for: a representative of the Delaware Health Care Commission, a representative from labor, a representative of the Department of Health and Social Services and two public at large representatives.
