




## WHAT TO EXPECT



#### 1-RECEIVE A PHONE CALL

Vital Research, an independent research organization contracted with DDDS, will conduct the survey. An interviewer will call you for consent to schedule a survey.



#### 2 - SCHEDULE YOUR SURVEY

Once you agree to participate, an interviewer will schedule the survey at a date and time of your choosing. You may choose to complete the interview in-person or remotely via Zoom video conferencing.



#### 3 - PARTICIPATE IN-PERSON OR REMOTELY

Share your opinions, feedback, and personal experiences with the services you've received from the state.

Your answers will not change the services you receive now or in the future.

#### A note for participants with a Guardian:

If you have a guardian, you will need their consent to participate in the NCI survey. If you are randomly selected to participate, Vital Research will contact your guardian first to receive consent.
