SUBJECT: 2026 Medicaid for Workers with Disabilities Unearned Income

Disregard

BACKGROUND

The Medicaid for Worker's with Disabilities Program (MWD) applies an unearned income disregard. The amount of this disregard is increased each year by the same percentage increase as the Social Security Administration Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA).

DISCUSSION

Social Security Administration has announced a 2.8 % COLA for 2026. Therefore, effective January 1, 2026, the unearned income disregard for the MWD Program applicant will be \$1,416.00. If an individual's unearned income exceeds the amount, they will not be eligible for Medicaid under this program. There is no unearned income disregard for a spouse.
