2025 HIGHLIGHTS FOR DMMA & CMCAC

Coverage for ENFit™ Enteral Supplies at Pharmacies

- In April 2025, Medicaid coverage began for ENFit™ bottle adapters and syringe products for eligible beneficiaries with a valid prescription at pharmacies.

Private Duty Nursing (PDN) Workforce Initiative

- Collaborated with PDN committee to develop resources that nursing schools can issue to students and obtain feedback that will inform DMMA's efforts to strengthen the PDN workforce.

Educational Resources for CMC Families

- Addressed several topics from the CMCAC “Parking Lot” through development of FAQs and a brochure that provide guidance for CMC families on Delaware’s Medicaid benefits, transitions in care, and eligibility-related policies. Resources available on [DMMA’s CMC website](#).
