PDN Workforce Capacity Study Recommendations	 DMMA contracted with the University of Delaware and Center for Research in Education and Social Policy (CRESP) in 2020. Goal was to look at the capacity of Delaware's PDN workforce to support children with medical complexities and their families. Five targeted areas: PDN Provider Agency Study COVID Telehealth Study Family Caregiver PDN Study Non-PDN Study PDN Study The SHHN assisted with input on the study design. Study results were given to DMMA in December 2021 and shared with CMCAC. Recommendations were developed for each of the five targeted studies. Next Steps: DMMA will continue work with SHHN and CMCAC on updates to recommendations; DMMA will evaluate and determine how to move forward. Other partners will be assets throughout the processes.
